Member Spotlight: BXCC

Since 1962, BX Civil & Construction, Inc. (formerly known as Buskerud Construction, Inc.) has provided construction services in South Dakota, Iowa, Nebraska, and Minnesota. Although the construction industry has seen numerous changes over the years, BX Civil & Construction has continued to adhere to the vision and values upon which the company was founded.

Historically, their work has included grading, pipe repair, highway guardrail, specialty railings, concrete paving, concrete joint repair, bridge rehabilitation, epoxy deck overlays and permanent

highway signing. At BX they are continuously adding, learning, and refining what BX has to offer.

A little known service BX provides is dust control. They spread dust control on gravel roads for homeowners and businesses. BX also has 2x2x4 and 2x2x6 concrete blocks used for retaining walls available at the ready-mix plant. BX will also provide dump truck hauling services, such as hauling anything that a landscaper may need for their job.

For those that work at BX, or may one day work at BX, they strive for a family-friendly atmosphere. They treat people as they would like to be treated, as family, and everyone is pretty close at BX.
